

**SCHEDULE FOR FIRST IN-PERSON COUNSELLING/DOCUMENTS  
CHECKING/HOSTEL ALLOTMENT (BE/BTECH)  
(MODE – 2 ONLY: BASED ON 10+2 PCM SCORE)**

**First round of In-person Counselling** for Mode – 2 only seats will be held on June 24-25 June, 2019 as per following schedule.

The candidates who have applied till 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 and are fulfilling the eligibility conditions of Mode - 2, as laid down in Institute Prospectus, can attend the counselling.

- The candidates who have been allotted branch during online counselling against Mode – 1 seats, have paid the fee, and are interested to change their branch through Mode – 2 seats are also eligible subject to the fulfilment of eligibility criteria of Mode – 2. Such candidates are required to pay the Hostel fee only.
- Further, the candidates who have withdrawn from Mode – 1 and also those candidates who have not been offered branch so far can also attend the counselling as per the following schedule. Such candidates are required to bring total fee and original documents.

**Note: -**

- Candidates are required to browse website [www.admissions.thapar.edu](http://www.admissions.thapar.edu) for update on vacant seat status. Candidates reporting on 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 should check the availability of seats on 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 (9:00 PM) before coming to the Institute.
- Seats will be allocated on the aggregate marks in PCM. In case of a tie, i.e. when two or more candidates obtain equal %age marks in 10+2 PCM inter-se merit of such candidates shall be decided in the following order:
  - Resolution by All India Rank obtained in JEE Main – 2019. Candidate obtaining higher rank in JEE Main - 2019 will be given preference.
  - Resolution by marks obtained in Physics in 10+2. Candidate obtaining higher marks will be given preference.

- Resolution by date of birth. Candidates, higher in age shall get preference on candidates with lower age.
  - If the resolution is not possible after this criterion, candidates will be given the same rank.
3. While calculating PCM score of 10+2, marks of Chemistry can be replaced by any of the technical vocation subject. Some of the example of technical vocational subjects are
- a Computer Science
  - b Informatics Practices
  - c Multimedia and Web Technologies
  - d Engineering Graphics
  - e Electronics

Please refer to technical vocational subject list of your 10+2 board for other available subjects.

4. The seats in the reserved categories will be filled as per the vacancies available on the basis of PCM %age.
5. The vacant seats of reserved categories will be converted to General category on pro-rata basis before the start of last round of counselling for General category.

#### **Instructions for BE/BTech 'In-person Counselling'**

1. Personal presence of the candidate/authorised representative during counselling/admission is essential for all eligible candidates seeking admission.
2. A candidate desirous of seeking admission against the mode-2 seats will bring the original certificates on the scheduled date of counselling/admission.
3. The allotment of discipline at the time of counselling/admission will be made on the basis of the seats available in a particular discipline and category at that instance of time, the order of preferences for various disciplines given by the candidate, and his/her merit according to 10+2 PCM score. The candidates appearing for the counselling shall have the option of either retaining the preference order given during the online counselling or can submit fresh preference order.
4. A candidate who reports late for admission during counselling will not be eligible for the discipline according to his/her original merit position but will be offered a seat in the discipline where the seats are available at that instance of time/day.
5. If a candidate is offered admission and he/she does not deposit the prescribed fees and original certificate immediately after selection, the offer so made shall be treated as cancelled and the seat will be offered to the candidate next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeal in this regard will be entertained.
